**BAC Resolution Declaring SCRB and Recommending Approval  
 RESOLUTION NO. 2014-04**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Tourism Promotions Board's (TPB) Office Order No. 2011-045 dated August 16, 2011, a Bids and Awards Committee was created to be responsible in bidding all the procurement requirements of the Corporation;

**WHEREAS**, TPB is in need of the services of a security agency to provide security and protection to TPB and its premises;

**WHEREAS**, the Tourism Promotions Board posted the Invitation To Bid (ITB) in the TPB website, the PhilGEPs and a conspicuous place at the premises of the Tourism Promotions Board continuously for 7 days (October 18 – 25, 2013);

**WHEREAS**, in response to said posting, three (3) security agencies signified interest and submitted their bids which were opened on November 5, 2013;

**WHEREAS**, upon checking of the submitted eligibility documents, two (2) bidders were found to be eligible, namely: Vigilant Investigative & Security Agency, Inc. and Merit Protection & Investigation Agency, Inc.;

**WHEREAS**, the bids of the abovementioned bidders were as follows:

Merit Protection & Investigation Agency, Inc.	Php3,549,423.60

**WHEREAS**, the detailed evaluation of their bids resulted to the Post-Disqualification of Vigilant Investigative & Security Agency, Inc. due to the following (as shown on BAC Res. No. 2013-041):

- Non-compliance with labor laws and standards
- Insufficient technical documents as required in the Terms of Reference (TOR)


**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of the bid submitted by Merit Protection & Investigation Agency, Inc., its bid was found to be responsive;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:


- To declare **Merit Protection & Investigation Agency, Inc.**, as the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid**;
- To recommend for approval of the Chief Operating Officer of the Tourism Promotions Board the awarding of the contract for the *Procurement of Security Services* to Merit Protection & Investigation Agency, Inc.




