### SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN ADDENDUM NO.03-2014

This Addendum No. 03-2014 is issued to modify or amend items in the Bid Documents. This shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

1. Bid Security to be submitted:

*Section II. Instructions to Bidders (15.1)*

*The procuring entity shall prescribe in the BDS the acceptable forms of bid security that bidders may opt to use, which shall include the Bid Securing Declaration and at least one (1) other form which shall be equal to a percentage of the ABC in accordance with the following schedule:*

Bidders are required to submit a **Bid Securing Declaration** and **one (1) other form of bid security** from the list as shown below:

Form of Bid Security	Amount of Bid Security (Equal to Percentage of the ABC)
1. Cash or Cashier's/Manager's Check issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank	Php50,160.00 (2%)
2. Bank draft/guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank: Provided, however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or Commercial Bank, if issued by a foreign bank.	Php50, 160.00 (2%)
3. Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security.	Php125, 400.00 (5%)
4. Any combination of the foregoing.	Proportionate to share of form with respect to total amount of security

2. Performance Security to be submitted:

*Section II Instruction to Bidders (31.2)*

*The procuring entity shall prescribe at least two (2) acceptable forms of performance security taken from two (2) categories below that bidders may opt to use.*

Bidders are required to submit the **two (2) acceptable forms of performance security** as stated below:

Form of Performance Security	Amount of Performance Security (Equal to Percentage of the Total Contract Price)
Cash or cashier's/manager's check issued by a universal or commercial bank	Five percent (5%)
Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security	Thirty percent (30%)

3. Tax to be submitted:

*Section III Bid Data Sheet*

27.2 (b)	<i>Only tax returns filed and taxes paid through the BIR Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS) shall be accepted</i>
	<i>Note: The latest income and business tax returns are those within the last six months preceding the date of bid submission.</i>

Bidders are required to submit EFPS.

4. Queries made by Iserve:

1. Question: Whose server will be used with reference to the TOR in item I. c.- Mobile Application Server  
Answer : Server of winning bidder.
2. Question: Why not use Igov?  
Answer : There are still issues pertaining to hosting under Igov.
3. Question: Who will contract the services of telecom companies for SMS?  
Answer : It will be the winning bidder's responsibility as stipulated in the TOR under Ie
4. Question: Who will contract the services of telecom companies after the 24,000 SMS has been consumed?  
Answer : TPB shall ensure that before 24,000 SMS has been reached or consumed, renewal of telecom services will be properly coordinated.
5. Question: What do you mean under item II d of TOR regarding updates/upgrades?  
Answer: Mobile app should be able to upgrade its apps from latest updates made by androids and Apple.
