Abel, a hand-woven fabric from the Ilocos Region of Northern Philippines, figures prominently in the lifestyle of the provinces.

Weaving is considered a prized traditional craft and is passed down from hundreds of generations to today.

Identifiable by the straightforward pattern on woven cotton from hardwood looms, the Abel weave is used widely in the Ilocano home and can be found on clothing, blankets, placemats and other home implements.
