INAUL CLOTH

A tradition from the province of Maguindanao, Inaul weaving uses cotton and rayon silk threads hand-woven to form traditional and contemporary designs that symbolize Maguindanaon culture. The old-age tradition, passed from generation to generation, was created exclusively for the Royal Maguindanaon Families in the past. Nowadays, it is used for many items including gowns, pillowcases, baskets and malongs or the traditional wraparound skirts.
