



T'NALAK CLOTH

Made from abaca fibers, T'nalak is a hand-woven cloth featuring various designs that tell stories inspired by the dreams of the women weavers of the indigenous T'boli tribe of South Cotabato in the southern island group of Mindanao. The fabric predominantly features three main colors - red, black and white, which are all natural dyes, and used for special occasions such as weddings, rituals and festivals. But nowadays, contemporary T'nalak versions are more vibrant and incorporated into fashion accessories and household items.
