TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

SERVICES OF A TOUR OPERATOR FOR THE TPB OFFICERS OPEN WATER DIVE COURSE

I. BACKGROUND

As part of TPB's Technical Enhancement Training, we will be conducting an Open Water Dive Course for project officers handling dive projects such as dive trade shows, partnership and familiarization trips.

The project officers tasked to promote Philippine dive must be equipped with the necessary knowledge about the market including but not limited to dive sites, equipment, terminologies, skills and techniques, among others. This will enable them to better converse and communicate with divers, tour operators and properties during familiarization trips and trade events and better market and promote the Philippines as a world-class dive destination.

II. OBJECTIVES

- 1. Improve the technical skills of the project officers by making them licensed Open Water Divers; and
- 2. Increase the knowledge of the project officers about dive to better equip them in marketing the country as a dive destination.

III. SCOPE OF SERVICES

Indicative date: 1st Quarter 2023 (indicative dates: 3-5 February 2023)

Number of participants: **17 pax**Minimum pax guarantee: 10 pax

1. Dive Course Requirements:

- Provision of Licensed Diver Instructor/Master
- Provision of equipment for rent and course materials (Tanks, Dive equipment)
- Provision of venue for Knowledge development sessions (academics), including whiteboard, flipchart, marker, eraser, pads and pencils or pens (if necessary)

- Confined water dive and open water dive classes, including conservation pass (dive pass)
- Provision of boat for transfers and open water dives
- Provision of LCD projector with wide screen or monitor with basic PA system with microphones during lectures
- Provision of PADI license to participants who completed and passed the course requirements
- Accommodation (maximum of twin sharing)
- Full board meals (AM and PM snack, buffet lunch and dinner) for 3D2N
- Provision of complimentary internet connection

2. Transportation:

Day 01 and Day 03

Three (3) units of a van (2018 model or newer) or two (2) coasters with driver inclusive of gas, parking fees and overtime fees for the following:

- **5. First Aid Kit** on board the tour vehicle with basic medicines (antacid for upset stomach, headache, catapres, antihistamine for allergies, diarrhea, motion sickness, fever, pain reliever, etc.)
- **6.** Incidental, other miscellaneous and on-site related expenses amounting to PhP10,000.00 (e.g., sampling of local delicacies, electrical consumption, gasoline, water expenses and etc.)
- **7.** Assigned one (1) tour coordinator including three (3) drivers, should be fully vaccinated with at least one (1) booster and shall undergo antigen test a day before the tour.

IV. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Assistance in preparing/ securing entry documents within Mabini, Batangas, as necessary.
- 2. Willingness to respond to immediate/unforeseen changes in specifications. Must be able to provide an alternative itinerary, in case of rain, risk of the typhoon, and other unforeseen or fortuitous events subject to the approval of TPB.
- 3. Willing to provide services on a "send-bill" arrangement.
- Bidders must adhere to the DOT Guidelines from the Memorandum Circular No. 2020-008 and 2020-011, as well as the IATF Safety Guidelines and Protocols.
- 5. *Dive activities and/or schedules/dates may still be changed* based on recommendations on the DOT Regional Office and IATF orders on local travel restrictions.
- 6. Bidders should submit a budget bid proposal that reflects the cost of tours, activities, and logistical requirements. The TPB-initiated requested sponsorship (hosted/discounted) will be deducted from the bid amount. Thus, the tour operator will bill TPB based on the actual cost per pax.
- 7. Valid Department of Tourism (DOT) Certificate of Accreditation.
