TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

SERVICES OF AN EVENT MANAGEMENT COMPANY (EMC) FOR THE CONDUCT OF DIVE 7

I. BACKGROUND

As a pioneer program of DOT-Region VII initiated in 2021, the DIVE7 Program promotes and supports the development of dive destinations in the region, provides easy access for the stakeholders to accreditation and licensing services, and advocates for environmental conservation and protection.

In partnership with concerned governing bodies, the DIVE7 Program features diving as a sustainable activity addressing key points on marine ecosystem preservation, conservation, recreation and leisure, and inclusivity. Furthermore, the said program, through its familiarization tours, dive stakeholders, members of the press, and influencers from various platforms, are invited to exchange ideas and experience known and emerging tourism destinations in Central Visayas, as part of the Regional Office's strategies to invite tourists to visit the region.

This time, the DIVE7 Festivals, in coordination with the Province of Cebu, will be conducting the DIVE7 Festival Medellin this May 25-28, 2023 with the theme, "Shoot, Ride, and Dive".

Shifting from the usual, this dive festival will have a variety of component activities as part of its celebration and launching of the dive industry in the municipality — Shoot, which will highlight the photography competitions, gun firing, and golf; and Ride, which features Motorbike Touring, a current demand for outdoor-adventure tourism, dubbed as MOTOR7, a circuit developed by the Regional Office.

The shoot component of the Dive Festival is a word play for the component activities involved. In partnership with the 53rd Engineering Brigade of the Philippine Army located in Medellin, Cebu, registered participants will experience gun firing in their firing range. Golf, another sport Medellin is known for, will be another component activity that will publicize and further cultivate the golf industry in the municipality. A tournament for golfers will be conducted alongside diving as the main focus of the festival. Lastly, underwater photography competitions will remain as this highlights the rich marine biodiversity in Medellin, Cebu.

Ride, focusing on motorbike touring, puts Motor7 to the limelight as an outdoor-adventure tourism activity and circuit, calling riders all over the region to experience Medellin. Because of the wide highways with scenic views in the Medellin aisle, the municipality is famous with local riders and photographers.

II. OBJECTIVES

The Dive7 Festival has the following objectives:

- a. To attract underwater photo enthusiasts and their buddies to dive and shoot in the identified dive destinations in Medellin;
- b. To promote sustainable tourism by conducting coastal and underwater cleanups;
- c. To promote camaraderie among dive stakeholders, partner agencies and LGUs;
- d. To further promote golfing in Medellin to the public and help the golf community attract possible members;
- e. To position diving as an activity for everyone;
- f. To promote the motor7 of the region; and
- g. To put focus on the Central Visayas Region as a dive destination locally, domestically, and internationally.

In line with the above-mentioned objectives, the Tourism Promotions Board is in need of an Events Management Company that shall provide catering services and entertainment for the DIVE7 Festival Medellin and Negros Oriental Awarding and Closing Ceremonies.
